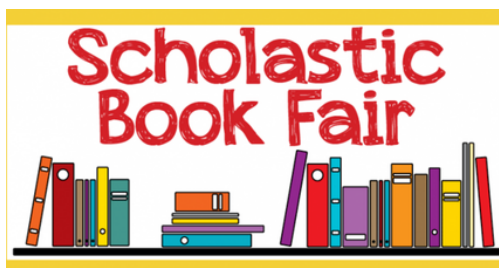

Well done to everyone!

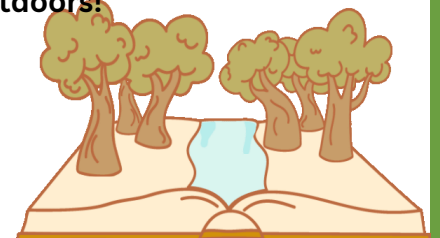


Learning Outdoors
