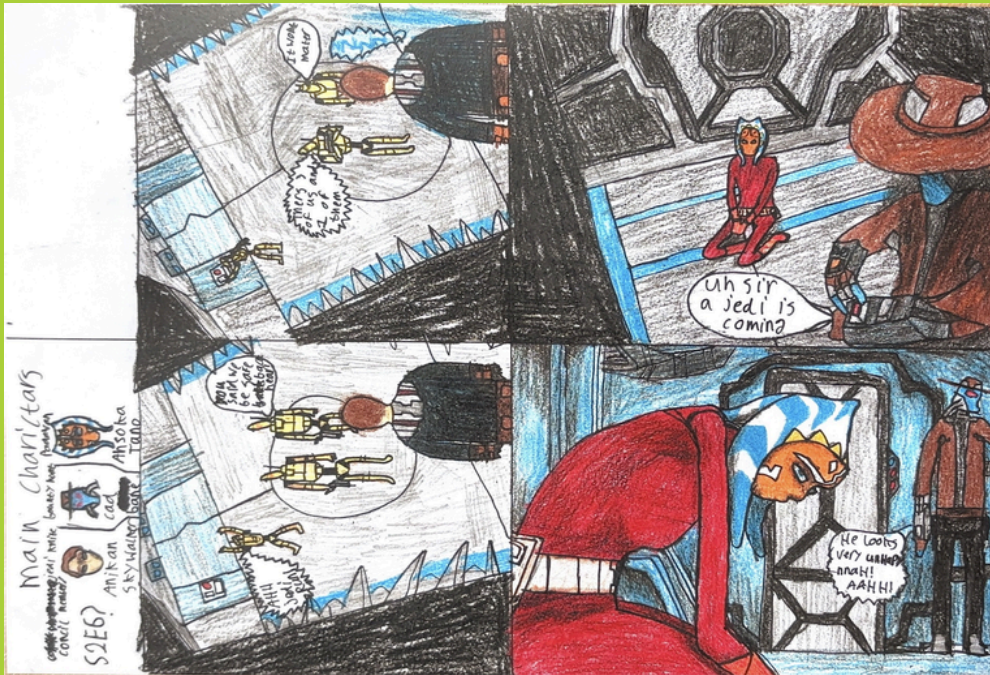

Hayden in Watergate Bay has been using his green time to create a comic book strip!

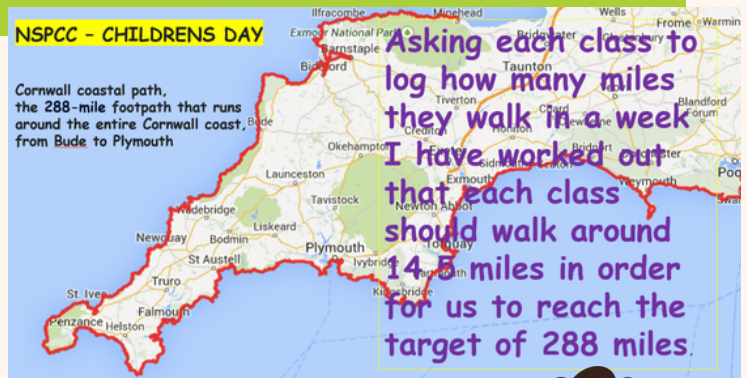
